1) 2023-2024 Revenue and Expenses Overview Maya Dimapilis a) Fundraising Summary

- Fundraising activities (captured in General Account) 42%
 apple sales, donuts, freezies, pizza and concessions
- Gaming grant 55% funds are based on \$20 per # of students from previous year
- Other 3% PAC funds and interest from short term investment

b) Expenses Summary

- General Account spends: Classroom funds \$200 per FTE used for extra and unique art supplies, soil and seeds from gardening project, ingredients for baking/cooking; supplies/equipment ie new Square machine for fundraisers and events; printing, photocopying
- Gaming Grant spends: Field trip subsidies ie aquarium, local parks, concerts; Schoolwide activities ie sports day and pancake breakfast; Staff appreciation and farewell gifts to staff

2) 2024-25 Budget Presentation

Leila Varizian

- Revenue will remain about the same as previous year
- Expenses are seeing an increase due to the deferral and carry over. Grants carry-over averaging approx.
 \$5K YOY
- Kitchener student population doubled in last 10 years, and staff numbers have increased too
- Notable changes outlined:
 - Field trip allotment will be increased from \$13.50 to \$15 per student because there hasn't been an increase since 2016 (earliest records we have)
 - Special projects will see a healthy budget of \$6,000 to fix or replace equipment – sports, music or arts related as suggested by parent community. Final items will be decided in consult the admin/school community.
- The PAC has built a healthy budget over the years and we are in a confident position to make these investments at this time.
- \$10K still remains in a GIC earning 4.5% and matures in November.
 No current plans for spend.
- \$4K from 2023-2024 fundraising efforts was deferred to 2024-2025 for a new fridge and shelving for the PAC room. The school will be purchasing a freezer to replace the current one.
- Motion made to approve the budget by Tracey Mayede-Lok, Andrew Tsang seconded the motion. New budget approved unanimously
